

Skunk Odor Remover

Ingredients:

1 Quart of 3% Hydrogen Peroxide

¼ Cup of Baking Soda

1 Teaspoon of dish detergent (Dawn dish detergent works best!)



Directions for use:

- It is strongly recommended to wear a pair of dish gloves before bathing dog! (The skunk smell will transfer to you)
- Mix and use immediately
- Comb mixture through the dog's fur
- Leave on for approximately 5 minutes. (Peroxide can bleach the hair coat so do not leave on too long!)
- Rinse thoroughly with warm water
- Rinse your dog's eyes out with saline solution
- Let your dog air dry if possible
 - The material that the skunk sprays is oily so it may take a few days to get rid of entire smell but you may need to repeat if smell is not gone.

If your dog has been sprayed in the face, wipe mixture onto a washcloth to coat fur to avoid getting in eyes. Your dog must be seen by a veterinarian if they begin to show signs of eye irritation, such as rubbing face, squinting, or keeping eye(s) closed.
